GENERAL ELECTIONS, AUGUST 6, 2026:**

**NOTICE TO ELDERLY VOTERS AND
VOTERS WITH DISABILITIES**

An elderly voter (60 years of age or older) or a voter with a disability, whose polling place is not accessible, may choose to come to the County Election Commission office to vote either during Early Voting or on Election Day by appointment or absentee by mail. If the voter chooses to vote at the election office on Election Day, the voter must provide the election office with written notice by July 27, 2026, of his intention.

If a voter registered by mail, he must vote in-person in the first election in which the voter votes. To request an absentee ballot, the voter must do so by July 27, in the Carroll County Election Commission Office.

Early Voting is scheduled for July 17 through August 1. Voting hours are Monday-Friday, 8:30 a.m.-4 p.m. and Saturdays, July 18 and 25, and August 1 are 9 a.m.-12 p.m., NOON. Early Voting is ONLY at the Election Commission Office.
